

Quality Enhancement Plan – Executive Summary

PEAK: Professional Exploration and Knowledge

Southwestern Community College (SCC) is dedicated to enhancing student success not only in academics but also in their chosen professional careers. SCC's Quality Enhancement Plan (QEP) stems from a two-year long process of identifying areas where students need direction and support in order to accomplish their academic and professional goals. After analyzing data and feedback from all stakeholders, the QEP was narrowed to focus on our students' learning in career exploration and planning.

We have named our QEP PEAK, "Professional Exploration and Knowledge," a name that encompasses the plan's two goals and their related learning outcomes that have been developed for the plan. Those goals are
